- Before teeing off on any given hole, Partners decide which format to play that hole:
 - a. Their own balls to the hole (Man), OR
 - b. Scramble (Scram)

The team ahead in the match must declare their intention first.

If teams are tied, the team with honors for the hole declares first.

- Each member of the 2-man team tees off. If playing <u>Scram</u>, the partners decide which ball to play.
- When playing <u>Scram</u>, use the usual PI Scramble ball placement rules (one clubhead, same general lie, no closer to the hole).
- 4. Scoring: Just enter the total number of shots onto your own personal card. There is a small advantage in handicaps for teams playing <u>Man</u> that will be reflected in the final score for the round. Both team members must update their own cards!


